Terms and Conditions

GPS FOGS 100 Club will commence on 1 October 2017. The subscription to the FOGS 100 Club shall be £10.00 per year per number, payable in advance by cash only.

50% of the monthly payments make up the 'Prize Fund', while the remainder goes into club funds. Members may have multiple subscriptions, up to a maximum of 5 per person. Anybody over the age of 16 can become a member of the 100 Club. Membership is not restricted to those associated with school and you are encouraged to get family and friends to join.

Each member is allocated a permanent number in the monthly draw at £10.00 per number. This number shall remain that member's number while their subscription is up to date. This number will be allocated by the administrator.

There will be one prize draw each month October 2017 – July 2018. The draw will be made in the first whole school assembly of each month by the Headmaster or member of the Senior Leadership team. This may change due to the timing of holidays.

In any matter requiring adjudication, the decision of the GPS FOGS Committee shall be final. The committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their discretion, and will provide reasonable notice to the members where necessary.

The monthly prizes awarded will be:

1st prize will be £30.00 2nd prize will be £15.00 3rd prize will be £5.00

The administrator will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within one week of the draw.

Winners will be notified by telephone, email, or by letter through their son/daughter at school. All prizes will need to be collected from the school by the owner of the winning number.

Winners names and numbers will be collated and made public at the GPS FOGS AGM and displayed on the FOGS section of the school web site throughout the year. It will also be necessary for them to be included in some communications.

If a minimum of 80 members are not recruited, the 100 Club will not commence and 'members' payments will be returned. If membership is 80-100, the prize money will be reduced accordingly in proportion to the membership.
