

Home / School Agreement 2014-2015

This agreement between parents, pupils and staff is to ensure we are valued and supportive of each other.

As a school, we will:

- Care for your child's safety and well-being
- Maintain a high standard of learning for your child
- Nurture positive attitudes to everyone regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values, age or need
- Ensure that each classroom is a positive and stimulating learning environment
- Set home learning which supports and extends the school curriculum
- Help your child to understand their role in the community
- Communicate effectively and sensitively with you
- Hold regular meetings to discuss the progress of your child and individual targets
- Provide information about behaviour or class work that may be a cause for concern or celebration
- Provide opportunities for you to become involved in school life
- Provide information to you about school activities, e.g. newsletters, open days and annual report
- Make available all relevant school policies

As a parent/carer we will:

- Make sure your child attends school and provide explanation if your child is absent
- Make sure your child arrives at school on time
- Attend consultation evenings to discuss your child's progress
- Support your child in home learning
- Ensure your child is suitably equipped and dressed for school each day
- Support and work with the school in any behaviour management issues
- Work in partnership with school to develop positive attitudes to diversity
- Inform us of concerns that may affect your child's work or behaviour
- Keep school updated of any changes in contact details
- Foster positive attitudes towards learning and the school
- Use discretion when discussing issues or grievances in front of children

As pupils we have a right to:

- be treated kindly and listened to
- be helped and feel safe
- be happy and feel wanted

As a pupil I will:

- Tell about any situation which I feel is wrong or upsetting
- Take home all school letters
- Accept responsibility for my actions
- Take appropriate responsibility for my learning, e.g. ask for help and to do my best
- Follow the school's expectations:
 - To listen and follow instructions
 - To respect ourselves, each other and our world
 - Be kind in our words and actions
